Among other responsibilities, Mr. Patiño coordinated the privatization and public placement of the Mexican Airport Groups, was responsible for the Financing of the Mexico City Airport Expansion (T2) in 2007, structured and financed several PPP projects as well as coordinated several rounds of privatizations of government toll roads known as FARAC.
